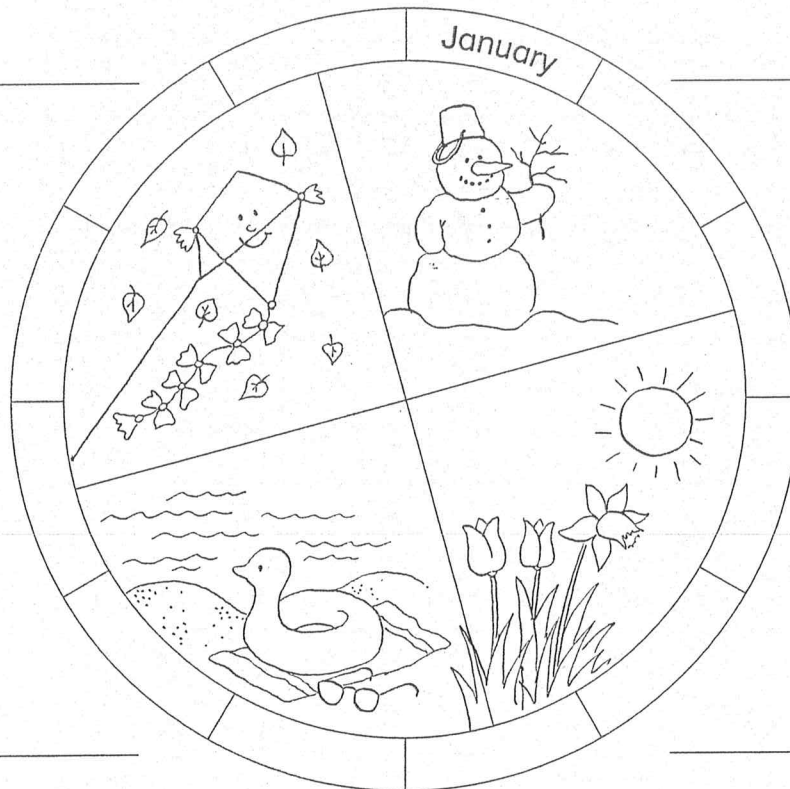

Which has twenty-eight days clear, and twenty-nine in each leap year.

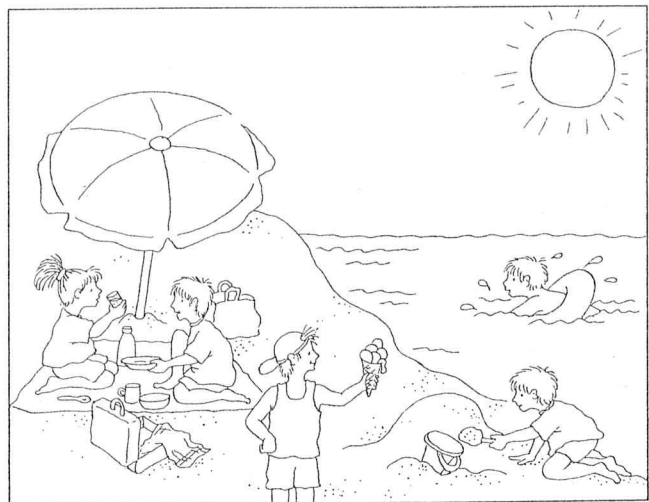
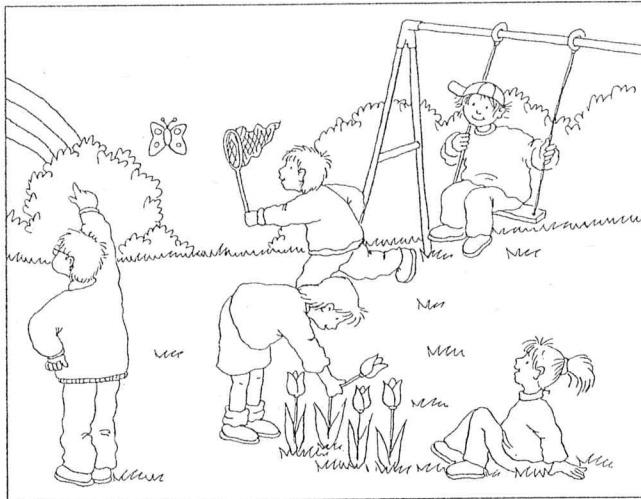
